Military law

If you are accused of a military offense and arrested by the Service Police, you are entitled to the same rights as you would be if arrested by civilian police. This includes the right to have a solicitor present during your interview.

Reported Cases

- **RVA** – We assisted an individual charged with disclosing private sexual images. Following representations made, the CPS discontinued the case as there was no realistic prospect of conviction.
- **RVG** – We represented a client charged with Dwelling Burglary and theft. This case was discontinued by the CPS due to lack of evidence.
- **RVE** – Sabina assisted a youth that had been charged with possession of a bladed article. Representations were made in relation to the vulnerabilities and good character of the youth, which led to the CPS discontinuing the case.
